Attention All Personnel actively involved in the Environmental Studies

From January 7, the Activity Restriction Index Level of the University of Tokyo has been changed from level 0.5 to level 1. Therefore, as of January 12, the following changes have been made with the management of the Environmental Studies Building.

- 1. Only two entrances with the IC card scanners will be accessible. This admission management is the same as the weekends and night time. Please refrain from access on weekends and night time as much as possible from the view point of safety.
- 2. All residents are requested to record his/her entry and exit by using the IC card scanners. (Card Reader System installed at the entrances, entry with blue and exit with red)
- 3. Regarding the admission of non-university personnel, please make sure that each laboratory has set up adequate countermeasures against the novel coronavirus infection. Also please keep the information of non-university personnel's visit at each laboratory in the same way as before.
- 4. In case you don't have a registered ID card, or your ID card has not registered but you need to enter the Building of Environmental Studies during the level 1 period, please contact the representative of your department or program. They will ask the Head of the Division of Environmental Studies for registration. Only if the Head permits, a registered ID card will be issued.
