- <u>Withdrawal from courses:</u> To drop a course, please directly inform the course instructors and notify both GSFS and UNU-IAS coordinators in writing. Regarding UNU-IAS courses, students can drop courses **only for a week after each course started**, and the withdrawal request needs to be approved by the UNU-IAS coordinator. If students drop a course later, the course will remain on their academic report as "Withdrawn with academic penalty (WDF)."
- <u>Plagiarism at UNU-IAS</u>: In case of the student committing fraud or plagiarism or creating the opportunity to commit fraud or plagiarism, the Academic Director shall be authorized to impose sanctions upon the student in accordance with the UNU rule on student conduct.
- Auditing of the courses at UNU-IAS is not allowed.
