

### **ACTION: CLUBHOUSES**

1. EURÊKA historical contribution was focused on an international charity called **Clubhouse**, that supports the recovery of **people with psychic illnesses** through a community. The Foundation helped create and develop a Clubhouse in France (Lyon), in Germany (Munich) and Italy (Torino) and are now considering expanding this program into USA (New York and New Jersey).

- 1. Inserm 3 years Marseille Fighting pancreatic cancer Identification of predictive signatures of chemosensitivity of cell subpopulations by single-cell transcriptomic analysis in pancreatic adenocarcinoma.
- **2.** Institut Curie 3 years Paris Immunotherapy Discovery and characterization of epigenetic antigens for cancer immunotherapy through artificial intelligence and integrative proteogenomics.


